1. Initial Set up

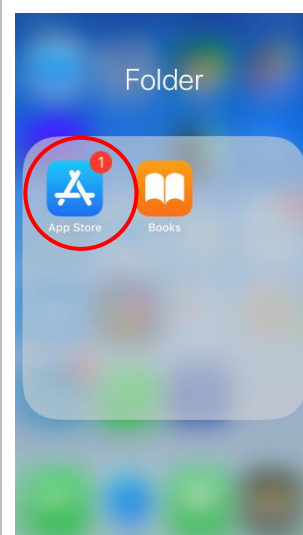
System Requirements

Version	iOS 10.x or above
GPS	Wi-fi models without GPS are not recommended

You may not be able to enjoy using a model that does not meet the system requirements. Smartphone battery is consumed quickly while playing. We recommend to bring a mobile battery.

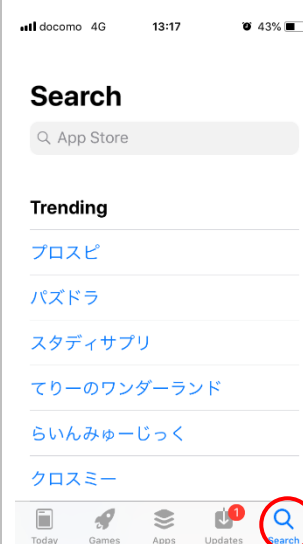
Install App

Select "App Store" and tap it.

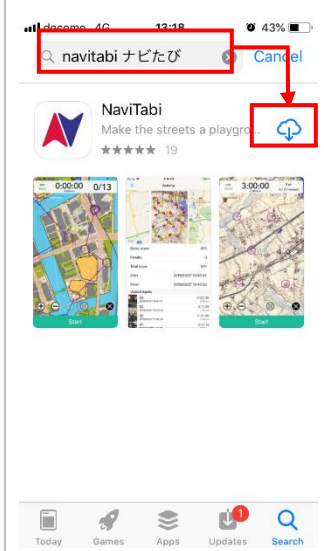


Select "Search" and display Search panel.

[Memo] You can reach the NaviTabi app by scanning this QR code.

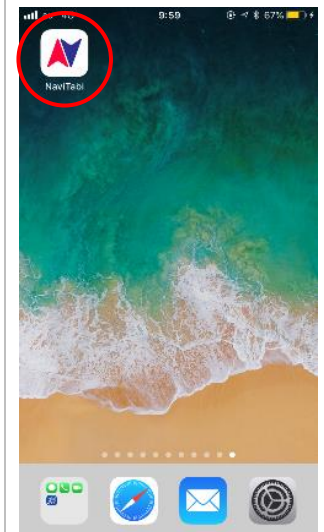


Enter “NaviTabi” into the search window. Once you see Navitabi app, install it.



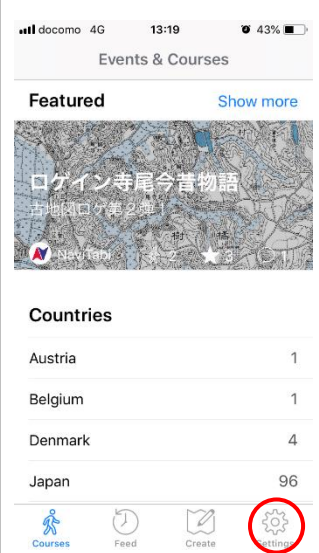
App is successfully installed.

[Caution] The installation destination depends on your iPhone.

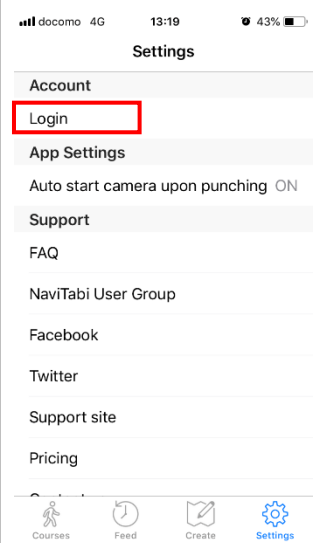


Initial Set up of App

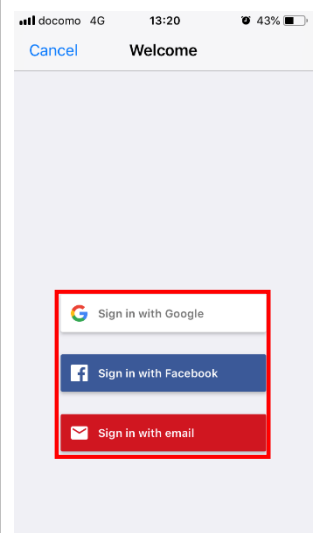
Launch the app, select "Settings" displayed at the bottom of the screen gear icon.



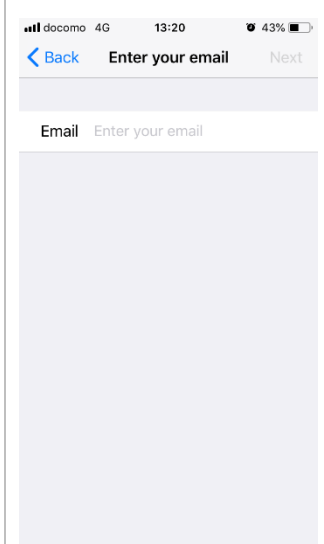
Select "Login"



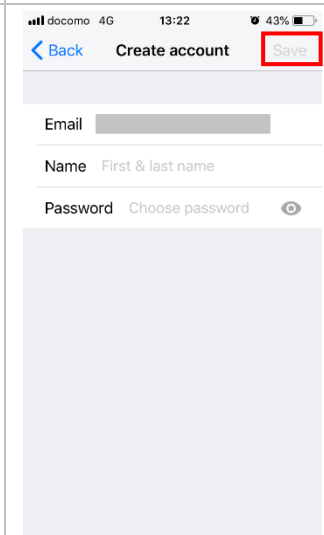
Select a login method.



If you select the "Sign in with Google," "Sign in with Facebook", so to jump to each page, please follow the instructions. If you select the "Sign in with email " and enter your e-mail address, please set a password.

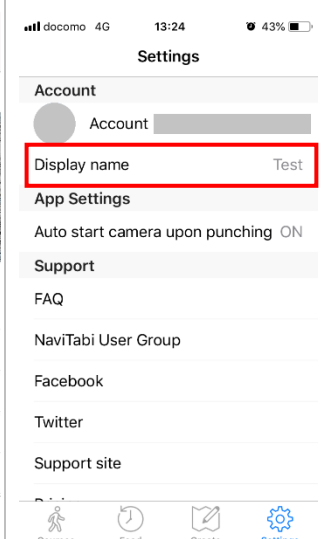
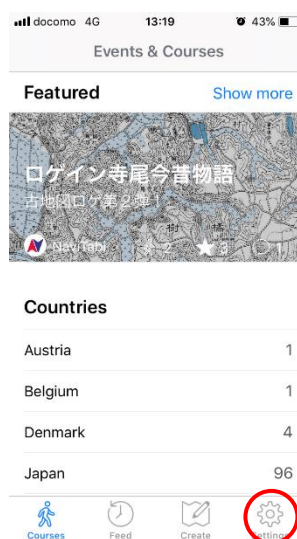


Enter your name and password, save them.



The name can also be changed later. If you want, select the "Display Name" from "Settings" button.

[Note] Display name also appears in the other players in results list.



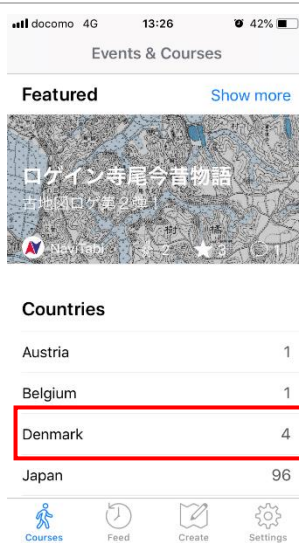
2. Play a course

Preparation to start

Select your country. If requested, select the area to join the event.

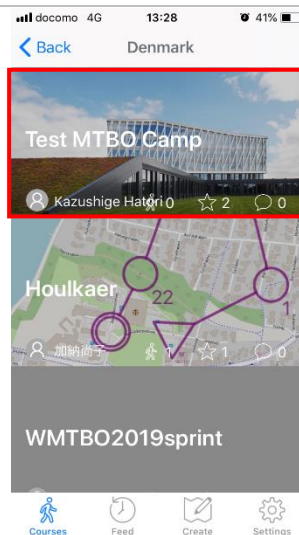
On the top, a “Futured” event which NaviTabi selects.

[Note] If someone is playing a course, yellow player icon appears on the country and area.



Select an event which you will join.

[Note] If someone is playing an event, a blue “LIVE” icon appears, and its player icon turns to yellow.



Select a course which you will join.

1. Type of Course

As default, Start and goal are fixed and play to gain score at each checkpoint. There are two options in below;

- Free Start & Finish: You can start and finish everywhere you want.
- Fixed Order: Aim each checkpoint in numbered order.

2. How to pass checkpoints

As default, when you arrive a checkpoint, you should punch (i.e. record the time you arrive) and take a photo of the checkpoint. There are two options in below;

- No Camera: When you punch at the checkpoint, you can leave without taking photo.
- Auto Punch: When you get close to the checkpoint within 40m, smartphone notice with beep/sound for 10 second and punch is recorded automatically.

3. Function on Map Operation

No location button: You cannot use "Location Button" to display current location. (refer to chapter of "Map Operation")

[Note] If someone is playing a course, its player icon turns to yellow.

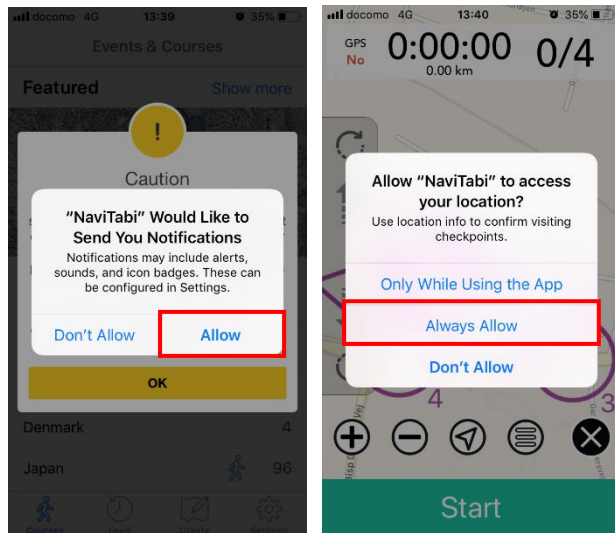
Select "Play".



For the first time, select "Allow".

On next panel, select "Always Allow" to give permission to record location information.

[Note] If you select the "Allow only during the use of this App", not "Always Allow", location information is only recorded while you are viewing the screen. Please change the setting through iPhone "Setting" app.



Map Operation

Left – GPS Precision

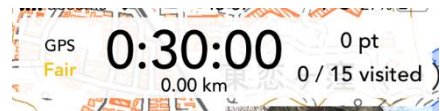
Upper middle – Left playing time

Lower middle – Moved distance (approx.)

Upper Right – Present score (for score course)

(Lower) Right – Number of visited point

[Score course]



[Map Rotation]

Both ways are applicable

- Drag up and down the translucent bar
- Two fingers rotate at the same time

[Zoom in]

Both ways are applicable.

- Tap "+" button
- Pinch in with two fingers at the same time
- Double tap

[Zoom out]

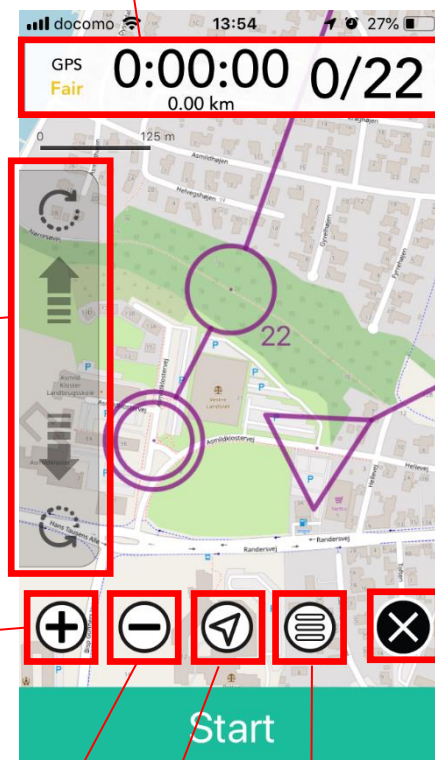
Both ways are applicable.

- Tap "-" button
- Pinch out with two fingers at the same time

Current Location Button

Push this button, map will move to locate current position to center of display.
Blink the blue dot to show current location.

[Note] On "No Location Button" course, current location button set inactive.

Back button

Return the previous panel.

Menu button

Show following menu.

- "Zoom to fill all spots":
Zoom out to show all spots.
- "Spot list":
Move to panel to see all spots.
(Next page)

When you tap the spot, you will see the name and photo. Tap the photo, you can see the description.

To stop the display of the photo, tap the map area other than the photo.

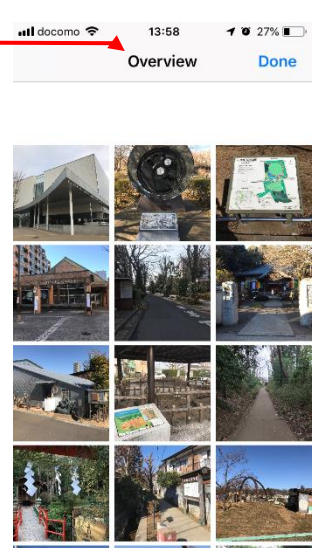


On the panel of "Spot list", you can see all of the spot.



When you tap a spot, description of the spot will appear.

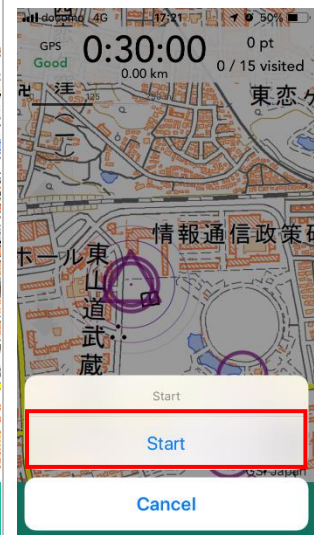
It is displayed in the order, or you can also display a list of photos.



Start

If you get close to start (Δ), your smartphone informs in vibration. Select "Start" and start to play.

[Note] In the course of "Free Start and Finish", there is no starting point (Δ). You can select the "Start" from anywhere.



Checkpoint

If you get close to checkpoint, your smartphone informs in vibration. Select "Punch".



If a quiz is set on the checkpoint, you will see two buttons to select to "Photo" or "Quiz". You should complete taking photo and answer quiz both.

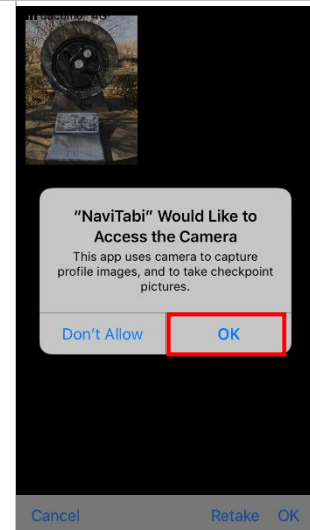
If you choose to take photo, select "Photo" button.

[Caution] If no quiz is set on the checkpoint, you will see next panel.



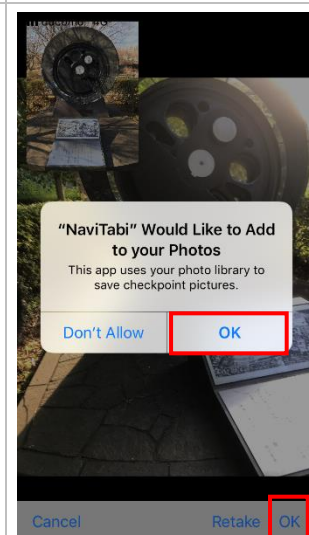
Select "Take photo".

[Caution] If you select "Cancel" unintentionally, you should take a photo with iPhone native camera app.



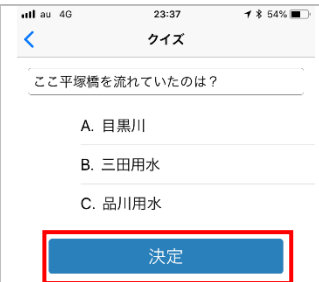
After select "OK", select "OK" to save the photo.

[Note] If you select "Retake", camera is activated again. You can select "Cancel" to go back to map.

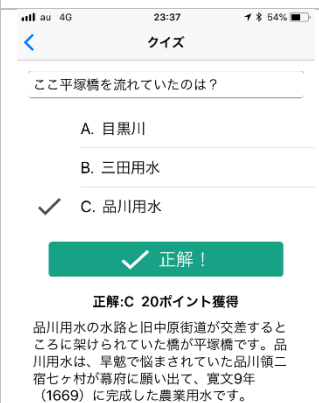


If you choose "Quiz" button, a quiz will appear.

You can tap an option you select and tap "Answer".



If you select correct answer, you can gain additional points.



If you select wrong answer, you cannot gain the point on quiz.

[Note] You can gain the original visiting points by punch even if you select wrong answer.



The checkpoint you take will turn grey.

[Note] You can confirm the list of checkpoint you take if you push "Menu" button and select "Visited Spots".



Finish

If you get close to finish, your smartphone informs in vibration. Select "Finish" to finish playing.

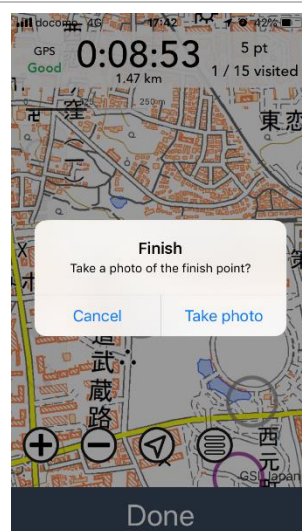
[Caution] If you exceed your playing time, left playing time turn to red and show the overspending time. Your score will be decreased based on course setting.

[Caution] On the course of "Free Start & Finish", no finish point is set on the map. You can select finish everywhere if you push "Menu" button.



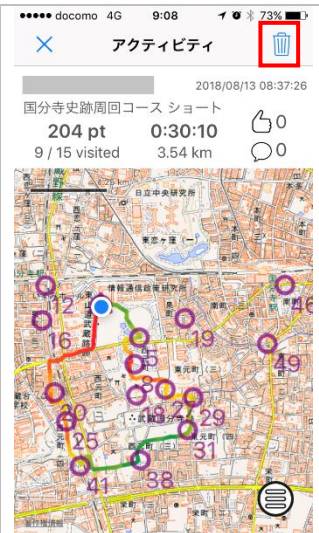
Select "Finish".

You can take a photo if you want.



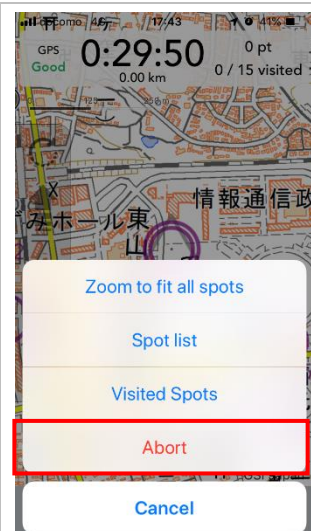
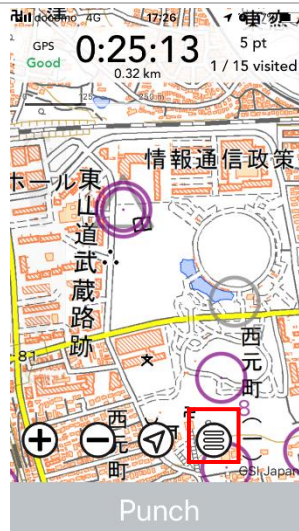
You can confirm the score, playtime and your route.

[Note] If you start unintentionally, you can delete your record at this panel. Select trash icon.



Abort

If you have to finish your play without finish, you push "Menu" button and select "Abort".

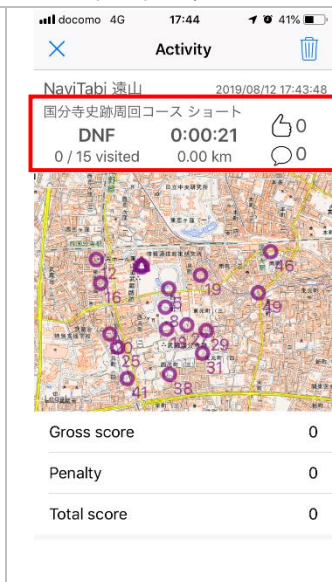


You will see confirmation twice. Select "Abort" in both.



Result will be displayed.

[Note] Result is recorded as “DNF” (Did Not Finish).

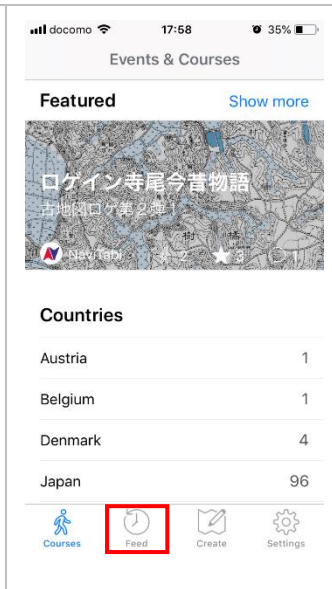


3. Confirmation of results

History

You can see your play result anytime unless you are playing a course.

Select “Feed”.



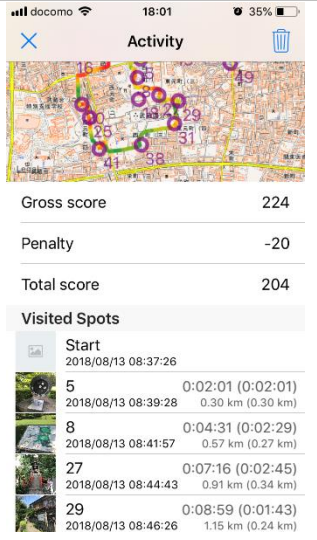
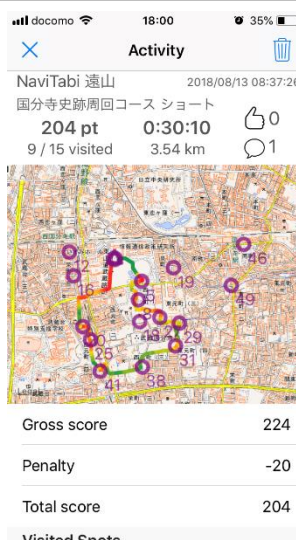
Select the course you want to see on “New” or “Me”.



Score and play time are shown in the upper panel. You can see your route.

[Note] You can delete your record on this panel.

By scrolling down the panel, you can see “Visited Spots”. Your visited time and thumbnail of photos you took.



Select a thumbnail, you can see the photo in enlarged size.

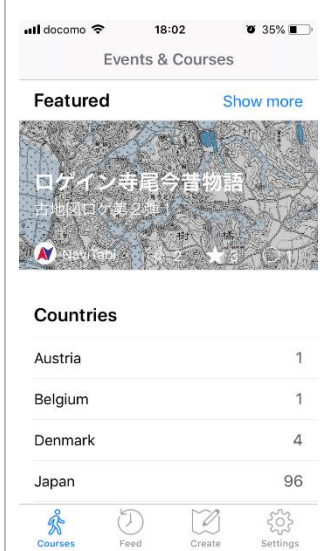


Results / Leaderboard (Ranking)

You can see the result in each course.

Select the course you want to see.

[Caution] You cannot see the result during you play.




Select "Results" or "Leaderboard".



On “Results” panel, players records are displayed in order of finish time (or abort time).

On “Leaderboard”, players records are displayed in order of score (or playing time).

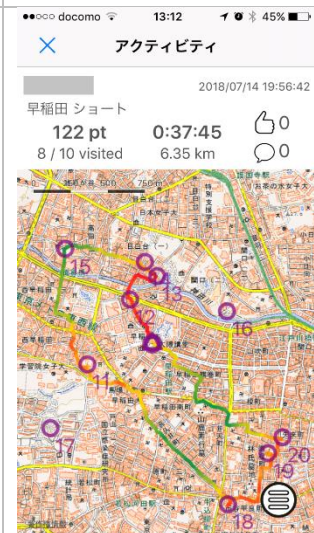

When you select a player, you can refer the playing time, route and other information as you see your own records.



4. Live View

You can enjoy how others play in live.

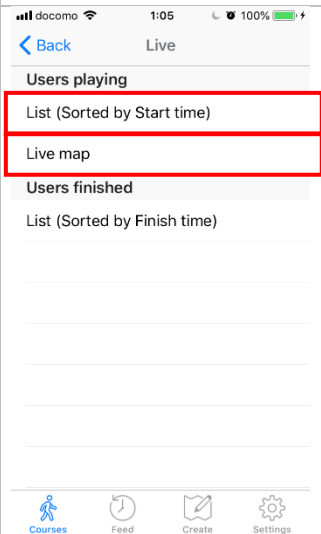
An event with live player can be distinguished with “LIVE” icon and the course can be distinguished with yellow player icon.

Select the course and “Live”.

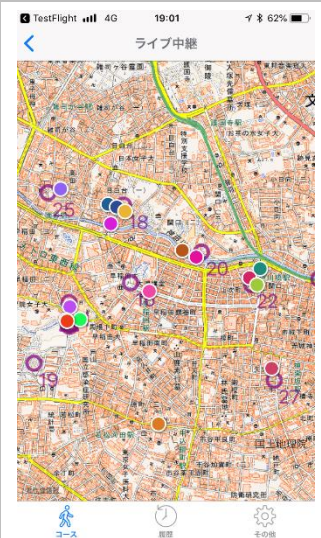


You can select “List (Sorted by Start time)” or “Live map”.

[Note] The results in “List (Sorted by Finish time)” can be confirm on “Results”.



On “List (Sorted by Start time)”, you can see the list of record in order of newest start time. On “Live map”, you can see the real-time location of all players.
